This assignment of his undivided interest in and to the lease by W. A. Springer, one of the lessees, to J. F. Sweeney, is approved, subject to the following conditions, which the assignee and surety shall agree in writing to accept:

1. Advance royalty accruing under this lease, as assigned, when paid shall not be refunded to the lessee because of any subsequent surrender or cancellation thereof, nor shall the lessee be relieved from his obligation to pay said advance royalty annually when it becomes due by reason of any subsequent surrender or cancellation of this lease.
