It is expressly agreed and understood that this conveyance is made subject to the provisims and restrictions specified in the Rules and Regulatims of said Burdal Park at the present time, and which are made a part of this conveyance, or which said Burial Park may hereafter make in conformity with the laws of the State of Oklahoma.
