

Now, furthermore, the commission of trade discount on all other sized and strokes and repairparts for same is to be based on actual manufacturing costs and sale price in effect at date of said sale. This commission or trade discount is to be computed on same basis as of the manufacturing and sale price and commission or trade discount of above 2" 10 to 42" stroke Hancock Working Barrel.

And, whereas, the term of this agreement is made to cover the entire life of the said Hancock Working Barrel license as heretofore mentioned, subject to cancellation at the termination or ending of aforesaid patent license granted by the Hancock Working Barrel Company.
