

said matter has been pending in this court for the required length of time to be heard upon application therefor, for the approval of a Full Blood Deed by herself as one of the heirs of John Washington, Deceased; said deed having been joined in signature thereto by the husband of said Petitioner, to-wit: George Crawford and same having been made and executed to one Sarah Rockwood and covering the allotment of the said John Washington, deceased, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, and covering the following described lands, to-wit: The Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 10, Township 18 North and Range 12 East; and

It being made to appear to the Court by proper testimony that the said allottee, John Washington, deceased, died on the 15 day of April, 1901 and in that portion of the Creek Nation which now comprises the County of Creek, State of Oklahoma, and that this Court is the Court that would have jurisdiction for administration purposes over the estate of said decedent and, therefore, has jurisdiction for the purposes of the approval of this deed by full blood heirs; and

It further appearing to the Court that the consideration recited in said petition for approval has been duly and fully paid over to the petitioner and that the aid consideration so recited is a reasonable consideration for said interest of said petitioner in and to said allotment, and that the same should be approved as prayed to be done; and said deed being exhibited to the Court for approval;

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COURT, CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND DECREED THAT the said Full Blood Deed heretofore made, to-wit: under date of December 20th, 1922, by the Petitioner Emma Crawford, nee Gumsey, joined by her husband George Crawford, conveying to Sarah Rockwood the said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 10, Township 18 North and R. 12 East, insofar as their inherited interest lies therein, be and the same is hereby approved, ratified and confirmed in all things, and said approval is hereby simultaneously endorsed upon said Deed so submitted for approval.
