I hereby certify that the land described in the above deed was purchased for a home for the said Almon Sawyer with funds Held In Trust by the United States for his benefit derived from oil royalties from restricted land allotted to said Almon Sawyer by virtue of his enrollment as a full blood citizen of the Creek Nation, opposite No. 1223 NB on the final approved rolls of Citizens by blood of that Nation, and that said purchase was made and said deed was executed, and the same is hereby approved pursuant to the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior under the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908, and the act approved August 1, 1914.

JOURNAL ENTRY

THIS cause coming on for trial this 14th day of May, 1924, before the undersigned Judge of the District Court, the plaintiff appearing in person and by her attorneys Dunn and Meyer; the defendant appearing in person and by his attorney W.A. Chase.

After hearing the testimony of witnesses of both plaintiff and defendant, the Court finds that the defendant is entitled to a decree of divorce upon his cross petition;

The Court further finds that plaintiff and defendant are the owners of Lots Fifteen (15) and Sixteen (16) in Block Fourteen (14) Greenwood Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma; and further finds that an equitable division of said property can be made by giving the plaintiff Mary Brooks, Lot Fifteen (15) and Block Fourteen (14) of said Addition. And by giving the defendant Alix Brooks, Lot Sixteen (16) in Block Fourteen (14) of said Addition.

It is, therefore, ordered, adjudged, and decreed that the defendant be and he is hereby granted a decree of divorce from the plaintiff upon his cross petition.
