The court further finds that said administrator G.H.Mead has discharged his trust with fidelity and that he and his bondsmen should be discharged and that said estate should be closed.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court.

1.

That the sole and only heirs of said Susannah Meade, deceased, were her children Charles Mead and G.H.Mead her sons, and Susannah Graham, now Susannah Emmons, her daughter, and that the real property involved in said estate descended to the said heirs equally.

2.

The court further finds that said Susannah Emmons is the sole distributee of said property, in as much as said Charles Mead and G.H.Mead conveyed their interest in said estate either directly or indirectly, to the said Susannah Emmons and that said property, to-wit:

A tract of land 140 feet wide by 185 feet long lying in the reserve part of Fears addition to Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, beginning at the point on the north side of L. Street, 439 ft. east of Main Street, running thence north 140 feet thence east 125 feet to the east line of said reserve; thence south along the eastline of said reserve to the north line of L. Street thence west along the north line of said L. Street, to the place of beginning, being in Tulsa County Oklahoma, and that said property above described be and the same is hereby adjudged to be the property of said Susannah Emmons.

It is further ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the court, that said administrators G.H.Mead and his bondsmen be discharged from further liability to hereinafter accrue.
