Whereas, Nannie Postoak, now Haney a citizen of the Creek Nation was allotted certain land, which land is restricted against alienation.

Now, "herefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 ( 35 Stat. L., 312), and the regulations of the Department prescribed thereunder, hereby remove, without conditions concerning terms of sale and disposal of proceeds, the restrictions on alienation of all the restricted allotted lands of said Indian Allottee and the restrictions on the alienation of all lands purchased for the benefit of said Indian allotee,

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
