For and in the consideration of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), to the undersigned in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I or we do hereby grant to William O. Bohnefeld of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma his successors or assigns, the right of way to passage at all times on foot, by wagon on automobile, on, over or through the following described lands, to-wit:

A strip of land twenty feet in width and running along the entire west line from the north west corner to the south west corner of the South West Quarter of the North West Quarter of the North East quarter of Section Nine (9), Township (20) North of Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Tulsa County, Oklahoma and the North West Quarter of the South West Quarter of the North East Quarter and the South West Quarter of the South West Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Nine (9), Township Twenty (20) North of Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, with ingress and egress to and from the same. The said grantors, their heirs and assigns, to fully use and enjoy the said premises the same as the said grantee, his heirs or assigns for the purposes herein specified.
