taxes, and judgments upon statutory lien claims, and interest thereon, as herein before provided for; and next, all of said note then due and unpaid; and next, the principal of such of said notes as are not then due when payment thereof shall be demanded with interest up to the time of such payment, and, if not enough therefor, then apply what remains; and the balance of such proceeds, if any, shall be paid to the said parties of the first part or their legal representatives; and in case of the foreclosure of this trust by suit, it is agreed that an attorney's fee of ten per cent, upon the amount found due shall be included in the judgment and decree of foreclosure.
