Now if said parties of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part his heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above described note mentioned together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then this mortgage shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assesseed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when same are by law made due and payable, the whole of said sum or sums , and interest thereon, shall then become due and payable and said party of the second part shall be entitled to possession of said premises. And said parties of the first part for said consideration do hereby expressly waive an appraisalment of said real estate and all benefit of the homestead exemption and stay laws of the state of Oklahoma----
