Lots Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) in Block Two (2) in GALBREATH-COLCORD-RUSSELL Addition to the town of Red Fork, Tulsa County, Oklahoma; according to the recorded plat thereof

Together with all and singular hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described premises unto the said F. B. Copsey his heirs and assigns, so that neither the said J. W. Bozarth & Blanche M. Bozarth or any person in their name and behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof; but they and every one of them shall by these presents, be excluded and forever barred.
