AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF THE ALLEY RUNNING THROUGH BLOCK NUMBER 100 FROM NORTH TO SOUTH, AND THE OPENING UP AND ESTABLISHING IN LIEU THEREOF AN ALLEY IN SAID BLOCK RUNNING FROM EAST TO WEST.

Be it Ordsined by the Mayor and City Council of the Incorporated City of Tulsa, Indian Territory:

SECTION 1. That the property owners in block number 100, within the townsite of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the plat thereof, as approved by the Secretary of the Interior on April 11th, 1902, are hereby authorized to change the alley running through said block from north to south and to open in lieu thereof and alley running through said block from east to west.

SECTION 2. That the said property owners are hereby authorized to file a plat showing the change of the original survey of said block, to that of the present survey there-of with an alley running through said block from east to west, and the closing of the existing alley running from North to South.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication.
