behalf of said first party and against the present claimants and encumbrancers of said property and for the purpose of establishing the interest of first party therein, and first party does by these presents hereby employ said second parties for said purpose.

Second parties hereby accepts said employment and agree to accept as their sole and only compensation for their services in the matter, and first party agrees to and does hereby give and grant, a sum equal to one-half of whatever is recovered for first party by way of rents, issues, profits or royalties pertaining to said above described properly and an undivided one-half interest in and to the interest as established, by suit or compromise, of first party therein. Second parties further undertake and agree to diligently prosecute said action or actions and to diligently handle all matters in connection therewith for the best interest of first party.

The parties hereto mutually agree that no negotiations tending to effect a compromise or settlement of said claim or claims shall be perfected or conducted without knowledge and consent of all the parties hereto and that no such settlement or compromise shall be effected without the consent of all parties hereto.
