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#263076 LLJ RIGHT OF WAY CONTRACT

49.6 FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE SUM OF \$59.50, the receipt, of which is hereby acknowledged, Geo. W. Handlin a single man hereafter called grantors, hereby grant unto Sinclair Pipe line Company, A Maine corporation, hereafter called grantee, the right to lay, maintain, inspect operate, replace, change or remove a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas and also the right to erect, install, maintain inspect, operate and remove telegraph and telephone lines and the equipment and apparatus therefor, if grantee desires to do so, to be used in connection with any pipe line hereafter constructed by said grantee on, over and through the following described land of which grantors warrant they are the owners in fee simple, situated in Tulsa County, State of Okla., to wit: NE4 of NE 4 section 36, Township 21N, Range 12E, N2 SE4 of NE4 Section 36, Township 21N, Range 12E together with the right of ingress and egress to and from said land for any and all purposes necessary and incident to the exercise by said grantee of the rights granted by this contract.

Grantors reserve the right to use said land for any and all purposes except the purposes hereby granted to said grantee. Grantee agrees to pay any damages caused to growing crops, pasturage and fences of grantors on said land caused by grantee's operations hereunder on said land. In the event the parties hereto cannot agree upon the amount of said damages, then the amount thereof shall be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons selected as follows: One by said grantor's one by said grantee and the third by two so selected, and the written award of said three persons so selected shall be final and conclusive on the parties hereto. Any pipe line laid hereunder shall be buried so it will not interfere with cultivation of the surface of said premises.

It is agreed that the terms, conditions and provisions of this contract shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
