REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE FRESENTS: That Charles J. Shellenbarger and Ada M. Shellenbarger, his wife of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, parties of the first part, have mortgaged and hereby mortgage to Emma Micholson party of the second part, the following described

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premises, situated in Tulsa County State of Uklahoma, to-wit:

Lot seven (7) in Block Five (5) in Pleasant View Addition to the City of Julsa, according to the recorded plat thereof, with all improvements thereon and appurtenances thereunto belonging and warrant the title to the same.

This mortgage is given to secure the payment of the principal sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) with interest thereon at the rate of eight per cent per annum, payable semiannually from date, according to the terms and at the time and in the manner provided by one certain promissory note of even date herewith due three years after date, given and signed by the makers hereof, and payable to the order of the mortgagee herein at the office of C. H. Nicholson, Tulsa, Oklahoma, or where the holder thereof may otherwise from time to time direct.

IT IS EXPRESSLY AGREED AND UNDERSTOOD by and betweenthe said parties hereto, that this Mortgage is a first lien upon said premises; that the party of the first part will pay said principal and interest at times when the same fall due and at the place and in the manner provided in said notes and will pay all taxes and assessments against said land when the same are due each year, and will not commit or permit any waste upon said premises; that the buildings and other improvements thereon shall be kept in good repair and shall not be destroyed or r removed without the consent of the second party, and shall be kept insured for the benefit of the second party or its assigns, against loss by fire or lightning for not less than \$1,000.00 in form and companies satisfactory to said second party, and that allpolicies and renewal receipts shall be delivered to said second party. If the title to the said premises be transferred, said second party is authorized, as agent of the first party, to assign the insurance to the grantee of the title.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND UNDERSTOOD that the second party may pay any taxes and assessments levied against said premises or any other sum necessary to protect the rights of such party or assigns, including insurance upon buildings, and recover the same from the first party with ten per cent interest, and that every such payment is secured hereby, and that in case of a foreclosure hereof and as often as any foreclosure suit may be filed, the holder hereof shall recover from the first party an attorney fee of \$25.00 and ten per cent upon the amount due, or such different sum as may be provided for by said notes, which shall be due upon the filing of the petition in foreclosure and which is secured hereby, together with expense of examination of title in preparation for foreclosure. Any expense incurred in litigation or otherwise, including attorney fees and abstract of title to said premises, incurred by reason of this mortgage or to protect its liens, shall be repaid by the mortgagor to the mortgagee or assigns with interest thereon at ten per cent per annum, and this mortgage shall stand as security therefor.

AND IT IS FURTHER AGREED that upon a breach of the warranty herein or upon a failure to pay when due any sum, interest or principal, secured hereby, or any tax or assessment herein mentioned, or to comply with any requirements herein or upon any waste upon said premises, or any removal or destruction of any building or other improvements thereon, without the consent of the said second party, the whole sum secured hereby shall at once and without notice become due and payable at the option of the holder thereof, and shall bear interest thereafter at the sate of ten per cent per annum, and the said party of thesecond part or its assigns shall be
