## AFFIDAVIT

That, he is President and General Manager of the Rex Machinery & Supply Company, a corporation with its principal place of Business in Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma; that he has been President and General Manager of said Rex Machinery & Supply Company for at least one year last past;
