The "orth Twenty and 31/100 (20.31 acres) of Lot Two (2) of Section Six (6) Township Twenty one ⁽21) North and Range Thirteen (13) East, and the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section Seventeen (17), and the East Half of the South East quarter of the South East quarter, and the South West quarter of the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section Eighteen (18) Township Twenty Three (23) North and Range Twenty five ⁽25) East. of the Indian base and meridian, in Indian Territory, containing "inety and 31/100 xx (90.31) acres, more or less as the case may be, according to the United States survey thereof, subject, however, to all the provision of the act of Congress.
