KNOW ALL MEN, That Ethel May Buckmaster, a single woman, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, hereinafter called mortgagor, to secure the payment of the sum of Fourteen-Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS paid by THE FIRST TRUST COMPANY OF WICHITA mortgagee, does hereby mortgage to said THE FIRST TRUST COMPANY OF WICHITA, the following described premises situated in the County of Tulsa Oklahoma, to-wit:

The West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Seventeen (17), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, of the Indian Meridian, containing in all 80 acres more or less, according to Government survey with all the appurtenances, and warrant the title to the same.
