ORDER FOR REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS  
DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR

Whereas, HENRY SPYBUCK a citizen of the CHEROKEE NATION was allotted the following  
described land, to-wit:

A tract of land described as follows: Commencing at a point 180 feet due south from  
the northeast corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW4) of  
Section Thirteen (13), Township Twenty-one (21) North, Range Twelve (12) East of the Indian  
Base and Meridian; thence due South 420 feet; thence due west 953.1 feet; thence due north  
300 feet; thence due east 174.6 feet; thence due north 91.3 feet; thence due east 206.7  
feet; thence due north 28.7 feet; thence due east 570 feet to place of beginning, contain-  
ing 9.03 acres, more or less, located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Now, Therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved  
May 27, 1908, (35 Stats. 312) and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the
