## P E T I T I O N

The petitioner, Daniel Barnett, states:

That he is a full blood Creek Indian and that he is an heir at law of one, Mary Kelly, deceased, and one Reuben Kelly, deceased; that the said Reuben Kelly and Mary Kelly were full blood Creek Indians, duly enrolled as such and died seized of the following land, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The said Mary Kelly died seized of the West Half of the Southwest quarter and Lot 8, in Section 9, and the east half of the Southeast quarter and lot 7, in section 8, all in township 19 north, range 12 east;

That the said Reuben Kelly dies seized of the southeast quarter of section 17, township 19 north, range 12 east,

that the said Mary Kelly died on or about the ----- day of -----, 1901, that the said Reuben Kelly died on or about the ----- day of -----, 1903, that both of the said deceased died while residents of and in what is now Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma; that there have been no children born to them or either of them since the 4th day of March, 1906.

Petitioner, further states that on or about the ----- day of -----, 1908, and prior to July 27th, 1908, he made, executed and delivered to ----- his deed of conveyance, whereby he sold and conveyed unto the said ----- all his right, title and interest in and to the lands described above, and that on this, the 26th day of October, 1908, he has made, executed and delivered to the said Charles Page and A. F. Ault, his deed of conveyance, thereby conveying unto the said Charles Page and A. F. Ault, all of this petitioner's interest in and to the said lands, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, which said consideration is adequate.
