That the seid Reuben Kelly, deceased, was a full blood Creek Indian, duly enrolled as such and died seized of the following described lands situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Southwest quarter of section 17, township 19, north, range 12 east,

Petitioner further states that the lands described above were allotted to the said Mary Kelly and Reuben Kelly, deceased, respectively, as their distributive shares of the lands of the Creek Nation; that the said Mary Kelly died on or about the ---- day of ----- 1901, and that the said Reuben Kelly died on or about the ---- day of -----. 1903, and that both of them were residents of what is now Tules County, Oklahoma, at the date of their deaths; that there has been no issue born to them or either of them since the 4th day of March, 1906, and that both of them died intestate.

Petitioner further states that on the 29th day of Sept., 1908, as one of the heirs at law of said Mary Kelly and Reuben Kelly, deceased, she made, executed and delivered to one, Charles Page and A.
