

Street, Chicago, Illinois, the same to be used by the said Salvation Army in its religious, charitable and missionary work in the Eastern half of the State of Oklahoma.

FOURTH. I hereby expressly direct that each and every beneficiary under this trust is hereby restrained from and shall be without right, power or authority to sell, transfer, pledge, mortgage, hypothecate, alienate, anticipate or in any other manner affect or impair his, her or their beneficial and legal rights under this trust during the entire term hereof, or any portion of the same, nor shall this trust be subject to the rights or claims of any creditor of any beneficiary, nor shall the same be liable to any process of law, and the income and principal under this trust shall be transferable, payable and deliverable solely and exclusively to the above designated beneficiaries hereunder and then only at the times entitled to take the same under the terms of this trust, and the personal receipt of the designated beneficiaries hereunder shall be a condition precedent to the payment or delivery of the same to each beneficiary by said Trustee.

FIFTH. I hereby direct that from the gross income derived from this trust estate, said Trustee shall first fully pay and discharge any and all taxes, costs, expenses, charges and liabilities incurred by it or to which it may be entitled in connection with the care, management and protection of said trust, including a compensation for its services as Trustee, as follows:

(a) An annual compensation, payable semi-annually, equal to one-half of one per cent of the reasonable value of the principal of the trust estate for its ordinary and usual duties as such Trustee.

(b) A Sum equal to one per cent of the value of the trust estate at the final distribution and closing of said estate.

(c) For the purpose of ascertaining such compensation, the reasonable value of the trust estate is hereby agreed to be the par value of all mortgages, notes, bonds and securities, and the reasonable value of all real and personal property on hand on the first day of May and November of each year during the continuation of this trust.

SIXTH. The said William Crossland reserves the right to revoke this trust at any time during his lifetime upon giving the Trustee sixty (60) days notice in writing of his intention so to do. Provided, that the said William Crossland, upon the revocation of this trust, agrees to accept all of the mortgages, notes, bonds, securities and other properties contained in said trust at the time of the revocation and agrees to assume all the existing contracts, leases, agreements and other obligations incurred in reference to the trust estate by said Trustee and agrees to fully release and discharge the Trustee from all liabilities and obligations of every kind affecting said properties so held in trust.

SEVENTH. During the continuation of this trust I hereby direct that reports of the condition of the same shall be made to me at least semi-annually during my lifetime and after my death such reports shall be made to my said son and daughter during their lifetimes.
