WITNESSETH, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 DOLLARS, to him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has quit claimed, granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does for himself, his heirs, executors and administrators, quit claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to him, and his heirs and assigns, forever, all his right, title, interest, estate claim and demand both at law and equity in and to the following described property, to-wit:

The South one-half of the Southwest Quarter, being otherwise described as Lot Seven (7), and the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Six (6), in Township Eighteen (18) north, range thirteen (13) east, containing eighty (80) acres, more or less; Together with all and singular hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described premises unto the said Chris Pearson, his heirs and assigns, so that neither the said party of first part, or any person in his name and behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof; but they and every one of them shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.
