IT IS FURTHER CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the cloud cast on plaintiff's title by the failure of the defendant, v. O. Rogers, to acknowledge said deed be removed, and that the defendants and each of them and all persons claiming by through or under them be forever barred and enjoined from setting up or maintaining any right, title, claim or interest in and to said premises.
