QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

WITNESSTH, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 Dollars to him in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, all his right, title, interest, estate, and every claim and demand, both at law and in equity, in and to all the following described property, to-wit:

All of Lot Eleven (11) except the North Fifteen (15) feet of the East Sixt (60) feet of said Lot Eleven (11) in Block Seven (7) Burgess Hill Addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, as shown by the recorded plat th reof,
