QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, Whereas, under date of April 15th, 1924, a judgment was rendered in the District Court within and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, wherein the undersigned G. L. Parris was plaintiff and judgment creditor, and J. M. Gillette was defendant and judgment debtor, said cause being number 19382, and in which cause said judgment was entered on the 16th day of April, 1924, for the sum of TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00) in favor of said plaintiff G. L. Parris against J. M. Gillette; and,

L. Parris, his heirs or assigns, as to any part of said judgment or as against any other real estate belonging to the said J. M. Gillette, but this waiver shall be strictly construed and confined as a waiver only of the lien of the said G. L. Parris as to the lot or parcel of land hereinabove described.
