## OIL AND GAS GRANT.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Harry B. Stone hereinafter called party of the first part (whether one or more), for and in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 Dollars cash in hand paid, and other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does, subject to the conditions and exceptions hereinafter contained hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey, transfer, assign and set over unto J. M. Allen (Post office address) Tulsa, Oklahoma, hereafter called party of the second part (whether one or more) the following described property, rights and interest, to-wit: An undivided 1/6th interest in and to all the oil and gas now in, to, or under or at anytime hereafter lying in, to or under the land hereinafter described and also a like interest in all the oil and gas rights and other minerals in, to or under the following described lands situate in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit: North one-half (N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>) of the Northwest quarter (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Sixteen (16) North, Range Twelve (12) East, less one square acre in southwest corner,

-And also a like interest in and to the oil and or gas bearing sands or strata in and under said land together with the right to party of the second part his heirs executors, administrators and assigns, at all times during the life of this grant, to enter upon, explore, develop, operate and occupy said land for the production of oil and gas or either and the storing, handling, transporting and marketing the same as fully in all
