# BILL OF SALE AND RELEASE OF LIEN OF LEASE.

10 Steel Tank Cars built by the General American Tank Car Company, lettered Diamond Refining Company, Kansas City and Tulsa, initialed D. G. C. X. and numbered as follows, to-wit: 2207-1470-1471-1472-1473-1474-1475-1476-1477-1478-1480-1482-1484-1486.

4 Steel Tank Cars built by the American Car and Foundry Company, lettered Osage Gasoline Company, Ochelata, Okla., initialed O. G. C. X., and numbered as follows, to-wit: 102-109-112-115.

2 Steel Tank Cars Built by the General American Tank Car Company, lettered Osage Gasoline Company, Ochelata, Oklahoma, initialed O. G. C. X. and numbered as follows, to-wit: 122 and 123.

4 Steel Tank Cars built by the General American Tank Car Company, lettered The Ajax Gasoline Company, Nowata, Oklahoma, initialed A. G. X. and numbered as follows, to-wit: 509-512-520-523.

And said Commerce Trust Company, grantor, herein does hereby release said cars from the lien and effect of a certain lease agreement dated April 1st, 1924, wherein Commerce Trust Company, grantor herein was designated as "Owner" and the Diamond Refining Company, grantee herein was designated as "lessee".
