A G R E E M E N T.

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 16th day of June, 1924, by and between Peoples Homes Corporation of Tulsa, Oklahoma, hereinafter styled party of the first part, and Margaret E. Biddle and Albert G. W. Biddle, wife and husband, hereinafter styled parties of the second part.

WITNESSETH, THAT, WHEREAS, on or about the 2nd day of April, 1923, the said parties of the second part entered into an agreement with party of the first part whereby party of the first part was to lend to parties of the second part funds for the building of a home upon the premises known and described as Lot Three (3), of Block One (1) Woodward Park Addition to the City of Tulsa in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, and being commonly known as No. 2332 East Seventeenth Place in said City; and

WHEREAS, the mortgage by party of the first part to parties of the second part upon said premises was to be evidenced by two mortgages, to-wit, a first mortgage for Thirty-five hundred Dollars (\$3500.00) and a second mortgage of about Twenty-three Hundred ^{fifty} Dollars (\$2350.00), and parties of the second part were to repay the same at the rate of Ninety-eight Dollars (\$98.00) per month which was to be applied upon the said interest covering the said first and second mortgages at 8 per cent per annum to be computed and deducted monthly, and the balance of each said monthly payment after the payment of such interest was to be applied upon the second mortgage until the same was fully paid; whereupon the said
