## R E L E A S E.

WHEREAS, the Illinois Merchants Trust Company, of Chicago, Illinois, a banking corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Illinois, with its principal office in the City of Chicago, County of Cook, and State of Illinois, as successor to the Illinois Trust & Savings Bank, of Chicago, Illinois, which was heretofore named as Trustee in a certain Trust Deed hereinafter described:

NOW THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Illinois Merchants Trust Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Illinois, as Trustee, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hereby remise, release and quit-claims unto The Tulsa Street Railway Company all right, title, interest, claim and demand whatsoever that the Illinois Merchants Trust Company may have acquired in, through or by a certain Indenture of Trust, dated February 1st, 1917, and filed for record in the office of the County Clerk in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, February 23rd, 1917, as Document Number 91522, and recorded in Record 206, page 365, of the records of said County, to the following described property: East one hundred and five (105) feet of Lots One (1) and Two (2), Block Seven (7), Orcutt Addition in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,

This release is not intended to change, modify, abridge, waive, diminish, discharge or affect in any way the lien of said Indenture of Trust upon the property therein described other than that above expressly mentioned; it being expressly understood and agreed that the lien of said Indenture of Trust shall remain and be in full force and effect, and it is expressly retained as to all such other land and property wheresoever situated.
