SHERIFF'S DEED.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That whereas, on the 14th day of January, 1924, in the District Court of the State of Oklahoma sitting in and for Tulsa County, in a certain action therein pending wherein E. H. Hanna was plaintiff and Carl C. Gray, Helen A. Gray, Sarah A. Megee, C. C. Megee and Mary K. Long were defendants, the said plaintiff, by consideration of the court, recovered a judgment against said defendants for the foreclosure of a mortgage upon the following described property situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:-

Lot Nine (9) in Block Ten (10) of Cherokee Heights Addition to the City of Tulsa, according to the recorded plat thereof;

to satisfy the sum of Thirty-nine Hundred Forty-eight (\$3948.00) Dollars with interest at the rate of eight (8) per cent per annum from the 14th day of January, 1924 until paid and all costs of said action.

And, Whereas, in said decree the plaintiff recovered a further judgment and decree foreclosing a certain other mortgage on said property to satisfy the sum of Forty-five hundred Three & 94/100 Dollars (\$4503.94) with interest at the rate of eight (8) per cent per annum from the 14th day of January 1924 until paid and all costs of said action.

And, Whereas, on the 25th day of July, 1924, an order of sale was issued out of said court by the Clerk thereof upon and in pursuance of said judgment, directed to the Sheriff of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, commanding him to cause the said land and tenements of said defendants described in said judgment and as above described to be sold according to law with appraisement as specified in said judgment and decree and as specified in one of said mortgages, and further commanding said Sheriff to make return of said order of sale with his certificate thereon showing the manner in which he had executed the same within sixty (60) days from the date thereof.

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
