REPORT OF COMMISSIONERS.

To the Clerk of the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma;

We the undersigned commissioners appointed by the Court to assess the damages which the above defendants property owners will sustain by the appropriation of the land in this case, do hereby find and report;

That the quantity of land taken by the plaintiff is-acres; that the value of the property taken is \$750.00 Dollars; that the boundaries of the property taken are as follows:
