KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, I. H. Scheer, of the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make and publish this, my last will and testament, hereby revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore made.

First. I direct that all my just debts shall be paid, and that the legacies hereinafter given shall, after the payment of my debts, be paid out of the estate.

Second. I give to each of my children by my first wife, namely Ida Sieling, Martha Rufeshofer, Annie Wilson, and Louisa Johnson the sum of One Hundred Dollars, each, to be paid to them as soon after my decease as conveniently may be done.

Third. I give, devise and bequeath to my wife, Sophia Scheer, the Northwest quarter of the Southwest of Section 22, Township 18 North range 14 east, also all my personal property including live stock, household goods, farm machinery notes farming equipment and excepting only monies, during her life time; after her death to be given to my son Alfred Scheer. Fourth. I direct that my farm consisting of one hundred acres, being the West half of the southeast quarter and the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter, less the southeast twenty acres of Section 14, township 18 north, range 13 east, be sold for the purpose of paying all my just debts, including debts on all my real estate.

Fifth. I direct that all the monies derived from the sale of the West half of the southeast quarter and the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter, less the
