RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: KNOW YE, that Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a
corporation, of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, for the consideration of One
Hundred Seventy -five Dollars (\$175.00), the receipt of which from the Sand Springs Railway
Company, a corporation, is hereby acknowledged, does hereby given, grant, bargain, sell and
confirm unto the Sand Springs Railway Company, a corporation, and to its successors and
assigns, forever, a right of way for railroad purposes over and upon a certain parcel of
land situate in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Block 36, Owens Addition to the
City of Tulsa; thence north on and along the west line of said Block 36, a distance of
Twenty-six (26) feet; thence northeasterly to the north line of said Block 36 at a point
forty-five (45) feet westerly from the northeast corner of said Block 36; thence easterly
on and along said north line of said Block 36 to a distance of forty-five (45) feet to the
Northeast corner of said Block 36; thence southwesterly on and along the east line of said
Block 36, to the place of beginning, containing .052 acres more or less, hereby releasing
and discharging all claims for damages to said premises, and to any adjoining and neighboring
