Udden in the pipe line or tanks to which any oil or gas well or wells on said lease may be connected the said one- twenty fourth ($1/24$ th) part of said gross production of oil or and gas from said leased premises free to the said Jon A. Udden of any cost of expense of development of operation.

The rights, privileges and property herein granted shall be deemed to be covenants running with the aforesaid oil and gas mining lease to be binding upon the lessee therein named and his successors and assigns.
