and authority on its part, after any breach in the ponditions of this mortgage, to collect and retain the same, the net proceeds to be applied and crecited to the payment of the s several items provided for herein.

"Appraisement is hereby waived under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, relating to forced sales of Real ... Estate".

To have and to hold the above granted premises, with all the improvements and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said Grantee, its successors and assigns, forever.

And the said granters for themselves and their heirs, executors and administrators, covenant, with the said grantee, its successors and assigns, that the said premises are free from right ecnumbrance, and that they have good/and authority to sell the same, and that they will warant and defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsever.

The conditions of this mortgage are such, that, whereas, the said Guy W. Settle and Grace H.Settle, his wife, have assigned, transferred and set over unto the texid The Oklahoma Savings and Loan Association, as a further security for the payment of the promissory note hereinafter mentioned, 12 shares of Installment Stock, in Class B. No. 17356, issued by The Oklahoma Savings and Loan Association, and have executed and delivered to The Oklahoma Savings and Loan Association, one promissory note bearing even date herewith, being No. 3801, for the sum of twelve hundred and 00/100 dollars,

Now, if the said Guy W. Settle and Grace H.
