REPORT OF COMMISSIONERS.

Comes now the undersigned, commissioners, heretofore appointed by the Court to inspect the real property hereinafter described, and to consider the injuries which the defendant, Lewis Pritchard, as the owner thereof, has sustained, or may sustain by reason of a permanent grant of a strip of land for a heavy traffic highway to the City of Tulsa, a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, and respectfully submit the following report;

The undersigned commissioners were, and are disinterested free-holders of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, and not interested in any like question; On the 5th day of July, 1923, they appeared before the Court Clerk of said County, and took the oath prescribed by law and thereupon proceeded to inspect the real property described as follows, to-wit:

A strip of ground as shown by the blue prints on file in the City Engineer's office of the City of Tulsa, said strip being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the southwest corner of lot 9, (nine) block 45, Owen addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma; thence north to the northwest corner of said lot; thence east along the north line of said lot a distance of twenty eight and six tenths (28.6) feet; thence southwesterly to a point on the south line of said lot, and a distance of fifteen and five-tenths (15.5) feet east of the southwest corner of said lot; thence west along the south line of said lot to the point of beginning.
