RIGHT OF WAY.

Know all men by these presents: That The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, a Kansas Corporation, in consideration of the sum of six and no/100 dollars (\$6.00) dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant; bargain, sell and convey and warrant unto Oklahom Gas and Electric Company, an Oklahoma corpora tion, its successors and assigns, the perpetual right, privilege and authority to erect, operate and maintain a line of poles, wires and fixtures for the transmission of electric current and telephone and telegraph messages over, upon and across the following described mal property and premises, situated in Tulsa County, State of Okahoma, to-wit:

> Over and across the northeast quarter of section 14, township 17 north, range 12 east, beginning at a point 132 feet south of the northeast quarter of said section 14, thence bearing north 490 nand 50' minutes west a distance of 197 feet to a point 146 feet west of the northeast corner ofsaid section 14, township 17 north, range 12 east.

Aldo granting unto said granteen its successors, and assigns, the perpetual right privilege and authority to cut down, remover trim any trees that may, in the judgement of the grantee, interfere with or endanger said line or its maintenances and operatin; also to set the necessary guy and brace poles or anchors and to attach all necessary guy wires thereto and to enter upon the above described premises for the purpose of erecting, maintaining and operating its said poles, lines and fixtures as aforesaid, and further granting to said granteenits successors and assigns, the right, privitege and authority to erect, maintain and operate such line or lines upon, over and across any street, alley, highway, railroad or other right of wayhow or hereafter established and existing on or across said prmises or adjoining the same or adjacent thereto.
