- 6. If at any time prior to the discovery of oil or gas on this land and during the term of this lease, the lessee shall drill a dry hole, or holes, on this land, this lease shall not perminate, provided operations for the drilling of a well shall be commenced by the next ensuring rental paying date, or provided the lessee begins or resumes the payment of mutals in the manner and amount herein above provided; and in this event the preceding paragraphs hereof governing the payment of mutals and the manner and effect thereof shall continue in force.
- 7. In case said lessor owns a less interest in the above described land than the entire and undivided fee simple exate therein, then the royalties and rentals herein provided for shall be paid the said lessor only in the proportion which his interest hears to the whole and undivided fee.
- 8. The lessee shall have the right to use free of cost, gas, oil and water found on said land for its operations thereon, except water from the wells of the lessor. When required by lessor, the lessee shall bury pipe lines below plow depth and shall pay for damage caused by its operations to growing crops on said land. No well shall be drilled nearer than 200 feet, to thehouse of barn now on said premises without written consentof the lessor. Lessee shall have the right at any time during broafter the expiration of this lease to remove all machinery, fixtures, houses, buildings and other-structures placed on said premises, including the right to draw and remove all easing.
- 9. If the estate of either party hereto is assigned and the privilege of assigning in whole or in part is expressly allowed; the covenants hereof shall extend to the heirs, executors, administrators, succesors and assigns, but no change of ownership in the land or in the rentals or royalties shall be binding on the lessee until after notice to the lessee and it has been furnished with the written transfer or assignment or a certified copy thereof.
- 10. The leased premises shall hereafter be owned in severalty or in separate tracts, the premises, nevertheless shall be developed and operated as one lease and all royalties accruing hereunder shall be trated as an entirety and shall be divided among and paid to such separate owners in the proportion that the acrage owned by each peparate ownersbears to the entire leased acreage. There shall be no obligation on the part of the lessee to offset wells on separate tracts into which the land covered by this lease may be hereafter divided by sale, devise, or otherwise, or to furnish separate measuring or receiving tanks. It is hereby agreed that, in the event this lease shall be assigned as to a part or as to parts of the above described lands, and the holder or owner of any such part or parts shall fail on make default in the payment of the proportionate part of the rent due from him or them, such default shall not operate to defeat or affect this lease in so far as it covers a par thr parts of said land upon which the said lesseeor any assignee hereof shall make due payment of said rentals. If at any time thre may be as many as four parties entitled to rentals for royalties, lessee may withhold payments thereof unless and until all parties designate, in wrating, in a recordable instrument to be filed withouthe lessee, a common agent to receive all payments due hereunder, and to execute division and transfer orders on behalf of said parties, and their respective successors in title.
- ll. Lessor hereby warrants and agrees to defend the title to thedland herein described and agrees that the lessee, at its option, may pay and disharge any taxes, mort-gages, or other liens existing, levied or assessed on or against the above described landes, and, in event it exercises such option, it shall be subrogated to the rights of any holder of holders hereof and may reimburse itself by applying to the discharge of any suchmortgage, tax or other lien, any royalty or rentals accruing hereunder.

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
