LEASE.  
CONTRACT.

This agreement made and entered into the 19th day of November, 1924, by and between Mulsie Chalakee and Tom Chalakee, her husband, parties of the first part, and R. B. Smith, party of the second part, witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter mentioned, the party of the first part has let, leased and demised unto the party of the second part for agricultural purposes, for the term of one year from and after the first day of January, 1925, the following described tract of land lying in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section 14, township 18, range 13 east, in said County, including homestead forty of Mulsie Bible allotment

The said party of the second part for the use of said land agrees to pay to the party of the first part as rent the sum of sixty dollars (\$60.00) to-wit: cash in hand, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

The party of the second part agrees to build a four room box house upon said premises, and at the termination of this lease party of the second part shall have the right to remove said house together with improvements placed thereon by him unless said party of the first part shall purchase same from second party.
