Witnesseth, that said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other good and valuable considerations, dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has quit claimed, granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents for themselves and their heirs, executors and administrators quit claim grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest, estate, claim and demand both at law and equity in and to the following described property, to-wit: The north half (N¹/₂) of the southwest quarter (SW¹/₄) of the southwest quarter (SW¹/₄) of section twenty nine (29) township nineteen (19) north, range thirteen (13) east, of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 20 acres, more or less, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the United States Government Survey thereof.
