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#### DRIVEWAY EASEMENT AGREEMENT.

This indenture made this 29th day of November, A.D. 1924, by and between W. Frank Walker & Olga V. Walker, his wife, and Irving Williams, and Bertha Williams, his wife, parties of the first part, and Curtis R. Adams and Frances B. Adams, his wife parties of the second part.

Witnesseth, that, whereas, the parties of the first part, are the owners of and in possession of lot twelve (12) in block fourteen (14) of Sunset Terrace addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, and the plat thereof, and the said parties of the second part are the owners of and in possession of lot thirteen (13) in block fourteen (14) of Sunset Terrace Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, and

Whereas, there is at this time a concrete driveway constructed upon the above described property, which said driveway is partly upon the lands of the <sup>first</sup> parties, and partly upon the lands of the <sup>second</sup> parties, and the parties hereto, desiring to make and use said driveway jointly for the purpose of reaching their respective garages for pleasure cars only, and each of the parties hereto desiring to give and grant to the other an easement on the lands affected by said driveway.

Now, therefore, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the agreement hereinafter mentioned on the part of the parties of the second part, do hereby give and grant unto the said second parties the right to use an <sup>easement</sup> ~~agreement~~ in and to so much of the land of the first parties as is affected by the said driveway, such right being the right of ingress and egress over said drive
