Witnesseth, that said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other good and valuable considerations, dollars, to us duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has quit claimed, granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do for themselves and their heirs, executors and administrators, quit claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest, estate, claim and demand both at law and equity in and to the following described property, to-wit: The southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) except ^{two} ~~to~~ acres in the southwest corner thereof, in section twenty nine (29), township nineteen (19) north, range thirteen (13) east, of the Indian Base and Meridian, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the United States Survey thereof.

This deed is given to correct a deed made by W.L. North and Emma A. North, his wife, to W.B. North, dated October 6, 1917, and recorded in the office of the County Clerk, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in book 228, page 506, in which deed the revenue was omitted, together with all and singular hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging.
