in the oil and gas rights and other interest hereby conveyed and assigned.

Subject, hower to any rights now existing to lessee or their assigns under any valid and subsisting oil and gas lesses heretofore executed by the then owner of the fee to said lands; it being understood and agreed that said party of the second part shall have, receive and enjoy his interest in and to all bonuses, rents, royalties and other benefits which may accrue thereunder from and afer the date hereof, and during the life of this grant.

this agreed that this grant shall remain in force for a term of 3 years from July 3rd, 1924, and if oil or gas or either of them is produced from any part of said land in paying quantities during such period this grant shall thereafter continue in force and effect until neither oil or gas in paying quantities has been produced from said land for a period of one year.

Party of the first part, for himself, his executors, administrators, heirs and assigns, hereby covenant that he will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands herein described and the rights and privileges hereby conveyed and assigned; and covenants and agrees to and with party of the second part that said lands described and said rights and privileges conveyed and assigned are free from liens and encumbrances of every kind except avvalid existing oil and gas lease.

Party of the first part further agrees to execute such further assurances as may be requisite for the full and complete enjoyment of the rights herein granted and likewise agrees that party of the second part, his executors, administrators, heirs and assigns shall have the right at anytime to red eem for party of the first part, his heirs, and assigns, by payment, any mortgage, taxes or other liens on the above land, in event of default of payment by party of the first part and be subrogated to the rights of the holder thereof.

It is agreed and understood between the parties hereto that party of the second part buys the interest herein mentioned subject to a certain provisims in an oil and gas grant from Jacob M. Bowlin, under date of July 3rd, 1924, to Harry B. Stone, whereby under certain conditions the sum of \$250.00 is to be paid annually; and second party hereby agrees to pay his proportionate parteof; \$166.66 of said amount in accorance with the terms of the conveyance to Harry B. Stone as mentioned.

To have and to hold said right, priviliges and property unto said party of the second part, his executors, administrators, heirs and assigns, free, clear and discharged of and from all formand grants, taxes, judgements, mortgages and other liens and ennumbrances, except as above stated.
