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FARM RENTAL CONTRACT.

This agreement made and entered into this 3rd day of December, 1924, by and between Ellis Haikey, of Bixby, Okla., party of the first part, and First National Bank, of Bixby, Okla. party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein after made, the party of the first part has let, leased, and demised, and does by these presents let, lease, and demise unto the party of the second part, for Agricultural purposes, for the term of one year from and after the first day of January, 1924, the following described tracts of land lying in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma,

The southwest ^{or} quarter of the southwest quarter and the east half of the southwest quarter all in section thirty (30) township eighteen (18) range fourteen (14) containing in all 120 acres more or less.

The said party of the second part, for the use of said land, agrees to pay to the party of the first part, as rent the sum of grain rent, dollars per annum during the term of this contract, payable as follows: One third of the grain cribbed on the place, one fourth of the cotton delivered to market at Bixby.

And the second party further agrees to pay 80 acres more or less in cotton and 40 acres more or less in corn.
