EQUIPMENT CONTRACT.

This contract made and entered into this 1st day of November, 1924, between Skelly Oil Company, a Delaware Corporation, with offices at the City of Tulsa, in the State of Oklahoma, party of the first part and C. J. Wupper and C. F. Peffley, both of the City of Tulsa, in the State of Oklahoma, parties of the second part, witnesseseth:

Whereas, the parties of the second part are the holders and owners of, and are in possession of the real estate hereinafter described under and by virtue of a certain indenture of lease, executed and delivered by Pauline G. Washington and Joseph E.
