An eight foot wide strip off of the north side of Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) in College View Addition to the Town of Broken Arrow, County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, said land to be used for highway purposes and should same be abandoned for highway purposes said land will revert back to first party or his successors.
