OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE UPON LAND SELECTED FOR ALLOTMENT * May 12, 1919
GREEK (MUSKOGEE) NATION, OKLAHOMA. *No. 39481

THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, Made and entered into quadruplicate on this 10th day of May A. D. 1919, by and between R. M. Holcomb, a Guardian of the estate of Sherman Brown, a minor, of Sapulpa, Ok. enrolled as a Full blood citizen of the Creek Nation, Roll No. M. 116 part of the first part, hereinafter designated as lessor, and H. E. Bridges of "Red Fork, Oklahoma party of the second part, hereinafter designated as lessee, under and in pursuance of the provisions of the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908, (35 Stat. L. P. 312) WITNESSETH:

1. The lessor, for and in consideration of one dollar, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the lessee, does hereby demise, grant, lease, and let unto the lessee, for the term of ten years from the date of the approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior, and as much longer thereafter as oil or gas is found in paying quantities, all the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land, lying and being within the county of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: The

North East Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section 25, Twp. 19N. and Range 11 East, and the North East Quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 26, Twp. 19 N. and Range 11 East,

of Section 25 & 26, Township 19, Range 11 of the Indian Meridian, and containing Eighty acres, more or less, with the exclusive right to prospect for, extract, pipe, store and remove oil and natural gas, and to occupy and use so much, only of the surface of said land
