RELEASE OF OIL AND GAS LEASE

WHEREAS, on the 1st day of June, A. D., 1918 Remington Rogers, Guardian of Wheeler Cooper, Creek No. 717, as lessors, granted to THE TWIN STATE OIL COMPANY, Tulsa, Oklahoma, as lessee, a lease for oil and gas and other minerals upon that certain tract of land situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, being

The Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter

(NE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF THE NW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 21, Township 19 N. Range 11 E., fully described in said lease which is recorded in Book 215 at page 523 in the office of the County Clerk of said county and state, reference to which record is hereby made for a full description of the land covered by said lease; and,

WHEREAS, The Twin State Oil Company is the present owner of all rights under said lease in so far as it covers or affects the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, Township 19 N, Range 11 E, and has good right to release the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The Twin State Oil Company, for and in consideration of \$1.00 to it paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby release all of its rights under said oil and gas lease unto said lessor, his heirs, assigns, successors and legal representatives, insofar as it covers the last above described real estate, and does hereby declare all of its right, under said lease relinquished.

This release in its operation and effect is limited to the oil and gas lease and premises last above described, and is executed and delivered upon the express condition that it shall not cover, release or affect any right which The Twin State Oil Company may now have or claim under any other or different oil, gas or mineral lease covering the above described premises, or any part thereof, whether executed by the same lessors or others.
