This day this cause came on to be heard, and was heard by the Court on the application of Maude Hayden Lindholm, Executrix of the estate of Frank Gustav Lindholm, deceased, for authority to sell promissory notes of said deceased, secured by mortgage.

And the Court being fully advised in the premises find that it is for the best interest to the said estate to sell said promissory notes in the application designated, as authorized by law.

It is therefore this day ordered by the Court that said Maude Hayden Lindholm as such Executrix be and she hereby is authorized and directed to sell said promissory notes in the application designated, viz:

1. Three \$500., one \$200. and three \$100. notes given by Henry S. Condon, Tulsa, Oklahoma, aggregating -----\$2000.00

All bearing 10% per annum interest payable semi-annually from Apr. 25" 1924, bearing date April 25th. 1923.

2. Two \$100., two \$200. and three \$300. notes made by Blanche B. & B. M. Drum, Tulsa, Okla., in all ----- 1500.00 with interest at 10% payable semi-annually, and unpaid since June 12th, 1924, dated June 12" 1922.

3. Four \$100. and two \$200. notes made by R. K. and Margaret C. Hughes and S. W. & Myra Mitchel, Tulsa, Oklahoma, amounting in all to -----800.00 and bearing date July 20" 1922, and 10% interest payable semi-annually, which is paid to July 20" 1924.

4. Four \$200. and two \$100. notes made June 12" 1922 by Blanche B. & B. M. Drum, Tulsa Okla., in all -----1000.00 with interest at 10%, which is unpaid since June 12" 1924.

5. Two \$200. and four \$100. notes made by R. K. & Margaret Hughes and Myra and S. W. Mitchel, Tulsa, Okla., July 20" 1922, bearing 10% interest, which is unpaid since July 20" 1924, in all -- -- -- --800.00  
Total-----\$3100.00

At not less than the face value thereof respectively, with accrued interest at the rate provided in said notes, to date of sale.

And said executrix is ordered to indorse and transfer said notes without recourse, and to transfer the mortgages securing the same, to the purchaser or purchasers thereof.

And of her proceedings hereunder she shall make due return to this Court.
